WORKING GROUP ON MARINE LIVING RESOURCES

Note by Chairman

At the conclusion of the Working Group's meeting on 26 September, it was suggested from the Chair that delegations might when discussion is resumed, consider the following questions:

- (1) What form of arrangement are we aiming at in the definitive stage?
- (2) In order to assist in determining what interim arrangements may be needed, and how detailed they should be, what timetable do we envisage for the negotiation of a definitive regime?
- (3) So that there may be a correlation between any arrangements e.g. for collection of data began in the interim period and what is envisaged for the definitive régime, what should be the scope of that régime, both geographically and in terms of species if the ecosystem approach is favoured?
